### **Resident of the Month**

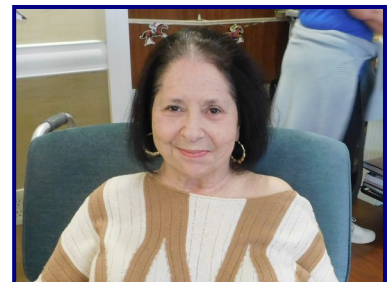
Our resident of the month for June 2023 is Mary Manning. We were blessed to have Mary join our family in March of 2022.
